What is it?

A Not-for-Profit organization, which can also be referred to as a Non-profit or 501(c) (3), is an agency, institution, charity, or company that focuses on programs designed to promote educational, charitable, other public benefit goals. Each state has different laws for non-profits.

Funding

 These organizations do not operate for profit. Funding is typically generated from grants and donations.

- Non-profits are usually exempt from state and local taxes.
- Donations are tax deductible.

Structure

- **Board of Directors**: Governing body for the organization
- **Programs:** Projects, services, and/or initiatives run by the organization
- Administration: Staff and personnel responsible for running the organization
